This exciting, unending series provides a learning journey by researching the familiar and not so familiar Gospel passages. Biblical references are KJV unless otherwise noted.

Can Love Conquer Established Prejudice? Summary: June 28, 1914, Assassination that Started WWI and the Personal Love That Endured to the End

The Invitation: In 1914, Bosnia-Herzegovina was made part of the Austrian-Hungarian Empire taken by the 1878 Treaty of Berlin from the Turks. In 1908 the annexation was completed. As to be expected there were many opposed to this new arrangement. It would also be deadly to the future Archduke Franz Ferdinand, heir to the Austro-Hungarian Throne, and his wife, Sophie von Chotkovato. They were the doomed married couple in this drama. He, not Sophie, was invited to review the June 28, 1914, Bosnian-Herzegovina military maneuvers. Sophie was a nobody.

Poor Sophie: She was not of the proper background to marry such a one as Archduke Franz Ferdinand. They had secretly exchanged love letters despite Franz's censorship by the family. The class structure was very strict with extremely limited flexibility. She just was not one of them.

The Marriage: Permission was grudgingly granted with very strong restrictions against Sophie. The one most important to this article was: Sophie was NEVER to ride with her husband. She did have the background to deserve recognition. But she did at her insistence on June 14th.

The Wrong Turn: The Mayor's car followed by Franz Ferdinand's car turned off the Appel Quay onto Franz Joseph Street. A fatal mistake. The assassin, Princip, was there

The Assassination: Princip stepped forward and fired twice. Franz Ferdinand was hit. Sophie took the second bullet meant for another, the second mistake. Franz was dying. He reached for his beloved wife, trying to grasp her hand, pleaded, "Sophie dear! Sophie dear! Don't die! Stay alive for our children!" She probably died while he pleaded with her in the carriage. He died minutes later

The Procession: No parade honors were given Franz Ferdinand or his beloved wife Sophie. The train bearing there bodies traveled back to Austria, no stops were made where citizens could pay there respects. Stops were at reached only at midnight. The train doors were never opened.

The Viewing: To further show their contempt for Sophie and Fritz Ferdinand for choosing such a woman for a wife, her funeral tier was placed several inches below his; not parallel as normal. The rigid class system still prevailed with no dignity or honor... even in death. They were buried together at night.


