

From Pastor Doug....

For many people, the winter months of January and February are difficult months. It seems that people who have a tendency toward depression wander a bit more deeply into it during these months and even those who don't normally have that struggle are a bit more melancholy. It seems that the longer period of darkness and shorter periods of light have something to do with this. That is why they have developed light therapy to help people cope with the darkness. Light therapy exposes people to additional light so that it does not affect them.

Spiritually, we find ourselves sometimes in darkness and it feels like we are going through the motions without any real connection to God. The good news is that we have "light therapy" for our souls as well. In Isaiah, God speaks through the prophet, "But there will be no gloom for those who were in anguish. In the former time he brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time he will make glorious the way of the sea, the land beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who lived in a land of deep darkness— on them light has shined.

You have multiplied the nation, you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you as with joy at the harvest, as people exult when dividing plunder. (Isaiah 9:1-3) A cute story in Homiletics Journal puts it another way:

Once there was a grandmother, struggling with a life-threatening illness, who had her little grand-daughter with her one Christmas. The granddaughter was watching her as she lit a candle and placed it in the window. "Grandma," the little girl asked, "why do we light candles on Christmas?"


"We light candles on Christmas, my dear, to tell the darkness we beg to differ."

The light of God through Jesus Christ is real. God has shined the light into the darkness and the testimony of Scripture is that God has done so to help us when we walk in darkness. In a season of darkness may our souls be made whole by God's light therapy.

The Friday Night Coffee House is booked through 2017, however I am going to try to rearrange some events so that it can be done by May 2017.


For those of you who were by my side during this ministry, I thank you. Your support really helped motivate me month after month.


